Sault College Offers New North Eastern Ontario Initiative for Employee Recruitment and Retention

(Sault Ste. Marie, ON February 24, 2010) It is predicted that Canada will continue to experience a shortage of workers in both the trades and supportive professions. (Ontario Futures; Statistics Canada, Census 2006) The same source indicates that by 2017 immigration will account for all net additions to the labour force in Canada. A new opportunity is available to employers to help them successfully source and select internationally trained and educated immigrant workers.

The Ministry of Citizenship and Immigration and Colleges Ontario Network for Education and Contract Training (CON*NECT) have collaborated to develop a training strategy to assist employers to adapt to this changing workforce. In partnership with 14 Ontario Community Colleges, they are making available the "Are You Ready?" workshops across the province. Currently, the workshops are available to participants from businesses and organizations employing fewer than 500 employees.
