Provides students with the skills and knowledge required for an entry level position in policing. Deals with the development, purpose and operations of the legal system, law enforcement and prosecution procedures.

**ENTRANCE REQUIREMENT:**

Ontario Secondary School diploma with Grade 12 English (ENG4C) OR Mature Student Status (an applicant lacking the formal minimum admission requirements may be admitted through the mature student application process. Mature student applicants may be referred to College Counselling for academic testing and a recommendation from the Counsellor to the Registrar for consideration in their admission. Mature applicants must still submit their high school transcripts and may also be asked for a resume).
