The Francis Pegahmagabow Memorial Scholarship

ROBERT ESHKIBOK

Francis Pegahmagabow (March 9, 1891 – August 5, 1952) was born on what is now the Shawanaga First Nation. He was orphaned at an early age and was raised by the Shawanaga First Nation community. Prior to the war, Pegahmagabow worked as a marine fireman for the Department of Marine and Fisheries on the Great Lakes. During the War, Francis Pegahmagabow MM and Two

bars was the First Nations soldier most highly decorated for bravery in Canadian military history and the most effective sniper of World War I. Three times awarded the Military Medal and seriously wounded, he was an expert marksman and scout. Later in life, he served as chief and a councilor for the Wasauksing First Nation, and as an activist and leader in several First Nation organizations. Elizabeth Vinassac established this award which is presented to a full-time student of Indigenous descent.

The Gary and Joanie McGuffin Conservation Leadership Award

AUSTIN YOUNG

Gary and Joanie McGuffin created this award, which was matched by the Ontario Student Opportunity Trust Fund, to recognize an Adventure Recreation and Parks student who best exhibits class leadership, community involvement/volunteerism, and contribution to wellness of the community and its environment.
